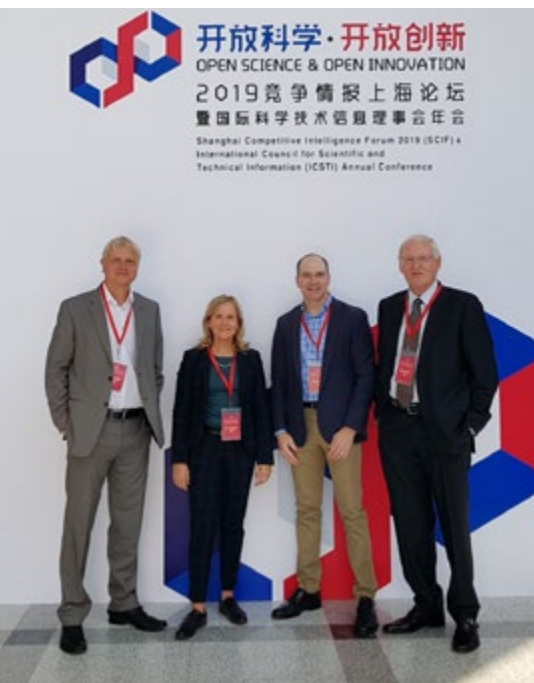

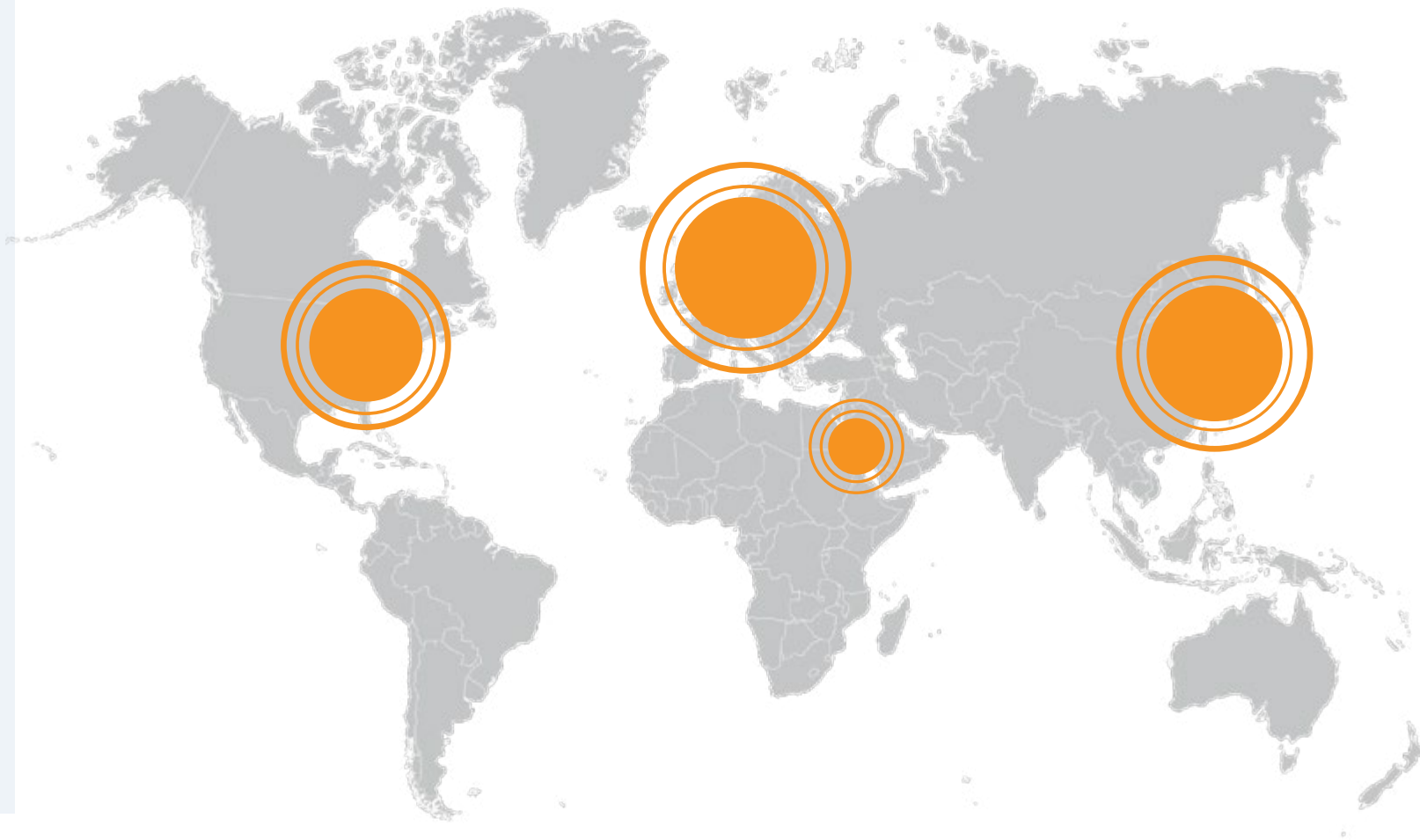
Since being established in 1984, ICSTI has hosted or co-hosted over 75 meetings, workshops, and other events around the world
