CONFERENCE-IN-SPEC, WORK ON GREY IN PROGRESS

Already sixty organizations will have a presence at the Sixth International Conference on Grey Literature. These organizations are located from coast to coast (New York to California) and from East to West (Japan to Canada). They represent the various sectors of government, academics, and business; and, together comprise a global forum in which your organisation is invited to participate. During this two-day event, some thirty presentations will be held both in session and panel format. They will deal with the key issues facing grey literature e.g. institutional repositories and collection development, content and use analysis, knowledge management and dissemination, as well as, IT and other research initiatives. PROGRAM AND ABSTRACT BOOK TO INCLUDE POWERPOINTS

The GL6 Conference Program and Abstract book (ISBN 90-77484-03-5) will not only contain the abstracts of the conference papers, the biographical notes, and the author's address information, but also the PowerPoint slides will be printed in this year's publication. Three slides will appear on the left-hand column of a page and the right-hand column will be lined in order to accommodate notes. The authors have been instructed to maintain a standard of two minutes for the presentation of each slide e.g. a twenty-minute presentation will display ten slides. The final date for submission of the PowerPoints is on 19 November 2004. After this date, the publisher cannot guarantee that late submissions will be bound and published.
