The House of the Province (*Provinciehuis*) is located on Koningin Elisabethlei 22 in Antwerp. The building-complex borders the King Albert Park (*Koning Albertpark*) and is in walking distance from the Ramada Plaza Antwerp. From Antwerp Central Station, take tram No. 2 in the direction of Hoboken and get off at the stop 'Provinciehuis'. Travel time is about 10 minutes from the city center. The House of the Province was constructed in various phases. The first stone was laid in 1966 and the two wings were added in 1974. In the park wing are the offices of the governor, clerks, and council. There are also a number of meeting rooms available for conferences. The other wing contains the impressive Provincial Council Hall and downstairs auditorium.
